Below is the procedures for earning Bright Future Community Service Hours at Timber Creek High School (TCHS).

The attached letter has been approved, by TCHS Guidance Department, to be used as the written community plan (item 2) when volunteering for Adriana's Attic. When your hours are completed you may contact us to sign off.

- The community service project must be pre-approved by your counselor **before** you begin your hours, and it **must address a social problem or concern**.
- Community service projects will **not accepted** if they were completed:
 - For a family member
 - Prior to the summer before entering Grade 9
- Please follow these guidelines to earn credit for your hours.

Guidelines for students:

1. Obtain the required forms from the school website or your guidance counselor
2. Develop a written community service plan **which addresses a social problem or concern**.
3. Submit the plan to your counselor for approval **before** you begin your community service.
4. All community service will begin the summer prior to entering high school.
5. Submit community service documentation to your counselor upon completion of the approved activity.

Our community outreach programs are designed to help those in need by providing clothing, hygiene supplies, medical supplies, food and other needed items to the homeless and low income poor. During the summer of 2019 we will have two community service projects.

Birthday Boxes

The first project will be in June and will involve volunteers creating "Birthday Boxes" for homeless and needy children in our area. Birthdays are not a priority for many families who are homeless or living in poverty, these boxes allow us to spread a little joy to a child on their birthday. Boxes will be created and distributed to the community as needed.

Back to School Supply Drive

Each year we sponsor an annual back to school back pack drive. Each child is provided a new backpack with items they need for the school year. This project includes gathering donated supplies and helping make and distribute back packs. The annual drive is in late July/early August and in 2019 over 100 back packs were distributed.

We have other projects throughout the year that students may want to volunteer for, including providing clothes to the homeless, making hygiene packages and holiday specific projects.

I hope that you find the charity to be a fit for the students to help our community and that they could earn Bright Futures credit hours.
